In accordance with the provisions outlined in the State Finance Act, Section 8.25-4 and in advance of each fiscal year, the Authority is required to determine its budgetary requirements to pay obligations under the provisions of any management agreement with respect to a facility or facilities owned by the Authority or any assistance agreement with respect to any facility for which financial assistance is provided under the ISFA Act, and to pay other capital and operating costs of the Authority, including any deposits required to reserve funds created for repair and replacement of capital assets and to meet the obligations of the Authority under any management or assistance agreement, and any amounts unpaid from previous years
