The firm's participation **will not** be counted towards both of these goals.
- 2. ISSUE Request for copies of current policies listed in Exhibit C
 - **RESPONSE** ISFA is not providing copies of current insurance policies as part of this RFP process.
- 3. **ISSUE** Request for underwriting information (e.g., exposure basis, insurance applications, loss runs, engineering reports, etc.)
 - **RESPONSE** ISFA is not providing the requested underwriting information at this time.
- 4. **ISSUE** Internal oversight of liability and workers' compensation programs
 - **RESPONSE** ISFA's Chief Financial Officer currently oversees the liability and workers' compensation programs.
- 5. **ISSUE** Current brokers/consultants for insurance, claims management, and loss control services, and their estimated annual compensation
 - **RESPONSE** ISFA's current broker is Willis. ISFA is not in a position to provide information regarding estimated annual compensation.
- 6. **ISSUE** Scope of services for the existing broker
 - **RESPONSE** The current scope of services is outlined in the RFP documentation.
- 7. **ISSUE** Consideration or implementation of alternative risk transfer programs or strategies in the past 3–5 years
 - **RESPONSE** ISFA has not considered or implemented any alternative risk transfer programs or strategies in the past 3–5 years.
- 8. **ISSUE** Current risk control focus areas and measurement of success
 - **RESPONSE** ISFA is not providing this information at this time. However, ISFA anticipates that Respondents will propose appropriate focus areas and methods for measuring effectiveness in exposure reduction.
- 9. ISSUE Areas where ISFA may need additional strategic resources
